

ATMS Modality:

Reflexology

Definition of Treatment

Reflexology is a natural non-invasive and holistic therapy that is well established and respected in the field of complementary medicine. It is also now being increasingly used alongside treatments in conventional medicine. Mostly this is focused on the feet and hands as Reflexologists apply a form of very specific and skilled form of massage.

This massage technique aims to stimulate the nerve endings in the feet and sends signals along the nerve pathways to the central nervous system where they are processed and filtered to the corresponding part of the body or organ being worked on.

The assessment must include the development of a specific treatment plan as to the best course of treatment for the patient's condition/injury. This treatment plan forms the basis of the clinical notes. These notes must be consistent with the ATMS Code of Conduct, the Unregistered Health Practitioner Act and the additional requirements set by the health funds.

Australian Unity	Completion of a Diploma of Reflexology HLT51707 or later equivalencies.	Names and details of eligible ATMS members will be sent to Australian Unity each month. ATMS members will need to contact Australian Unity on 1800 035 360 to register as a provider, after filling out the Australian Unity Application Form located on the ATMS website to activate their provider status. This only needs to happen the first time. Your ATMS number can be used as your Provider Number, or you can contact Australian Unity for your Australian Unity generated Provider Number.
BUPA	Completion of a Diploma of Reflexology HLT51707 or later equivalencies. Any educational qualifications substantially attained by distance only learning, online learning and external mode will not be recognised.	Names and details of eligible ATMS members will be sent to BUPA on a weekly basis. BUPA will generate a Provider Number after receiving the list of eligible practitioners. BUPA advises ATMS of your Provider Number and ATMS will then advise those members directly.
CBHS Health Fund	Meets ATMS requirements.	Names and details of eligible ATMS members will be sent to CBHS each month. Your ATMS number will be your Provider Number.

Health Partners	Meets ATMS requirements.	Names and details of eligible ATMS members will be sent to Health Partners each month. Your ATMS number will be your Provider Number.
HBF	Completion of a Diploma of Reflexology HLT51707 or later equivalencies.	Names and details of eligible ATMS members will be sent to HBF each month. HBF requires all providers who wish to register with HBF to fill out an application form available on the HBF website www.hbf.com.au. Once HBF approves the provider, they will generate provider numbers after they receive the first claim from your first HBF client.
HCF	Completion of a Diploma of Reflexology HLT51707 or later equivalencies and must include an adequate component of supervised clinical training. Courses delivered online or by distance education will not be accepted.	Names and details of eligible ATMS members will be sent to HCF on a weekly basis. Your ATMS number will be your Provider Number.
Medibank Private	 Completion of a government accredited Certificate IV in Reflexology or an association accredited Diploma in Reflexology consisting of: 100 hours of Reflexology Theory and Practice 100 hours of other complementary therapy techniques including nutrition, bach flower remedies and tissue salts 50 hours of anatomy and physiology 30 hours of supervised clinical training 20 hours of practice management Qualifications completed by correspondence only and/or the clinical training not supervised will not be recognised. Names and details of eligible ATMS members will be sent to Medibank Private on a monthly basis.
